## **EXPECTATIONS**

#### ATTENDANCE

Dancers cannot miss more than 3 weekdays per session and 2 team practices TOTAL. Ideally, we do not want dancers missing classes for any reason, but we understand that things can come up or dancers get sick. Please plan vacations and trips for weekends that we do not have mini team.



#### CLASS REQUIREMENTS

FALL / SPRING: Ballet, Jazz, and one additional class (minimum). We encourage dancers to take all styles to become a well rounded dancer.



#### ATTITUDE AND RESPECT

We expect all dancers to respect their teachers, parents and peers. We will not tolerate poor attitude anywhere at the studio. Many dancers at the studio look up to the team dancers, therefore they should all be good role models. Dancers who cannot abide by this will be dismissed from team.



#### STUDIO & CLASSROOM ETIOUETTE

STUDIO: Respect the space, including throwing away garbage and picking up after yourself. There is NO jumping/climbing on furniture, or practicing skills that are unsafe without a teacher present.

CLASSROOM: Arrive to all classes on time, dressed in proper attire, and hair up (off face). They must be ready to listen in a classroom and pay attention to the teacher.
